- ⑤ Buy consumer electronics and appliances with the ENERGY STAR logo can save you more than \$80 a year.
- ⑤ Unplug battery chargers and power adapters when not in use, and turn off lights when you leave a room.
- ⑤ Install a programmable thermostat - you can save \$100 a year.
